- A) Delaware Estuary Watershed Grant – update on ideas or comments. Donna will invite Carole Brodtkin to next meeting.
- B) Trail Guide-completed by Mike Hogan. Copies to be made available on web site and hard copy. Mike Hogan will organize a press release for trail guide in early May. Nine stations will have trail guide stations. Frank will look into station markers. Trash cans needed for trail. Services of surveyor and township engineer (Fralinger) to set corners of property. Cost; \$12,000. Trail grant funds can be used for these services with permission from DEP. Contingency is to set corners of trail for \$3,000-\$4,000. This can be done within grant. (All voted in favor of latter option) Extra fencing and posts available and can be put on Township property at trail near soccer field.
- C) Electronic recycling: Has started. Steve Alexander will provide information for pick up. Information will appear in newsletter.
- D) Arbor Day: Billie will reach out to Aura School re: contests and order seedlings. Donna W. will contact environmental agencies for information for Arbor Day.
